PREFACE

This publication presents data on the value and volume of trade between The Bahamas and the rest of the world. It contains a five year series of summary data to provide an historical view of trade for The Bahamas during that period. Detailed tables (both annual and quarterly) of the year 2012 are presented in order to provide an in depth view of trade for that year. Also included in this publication for the first time is a synopsis of the results of the Department's first ever Export/Import Price Index (**XMPI**). The tables presented reflect annually data for a four year period 2008-2011, with 2007 as the base year. These data provide insight into the price trends of imports and exports and are an important addition to the statistical series compiled by the Department of Statistics. See pages 71-73 for further details on compilation methodology.

Reports on trade statistics for The Bahamas have been published since 1968 and have undergone many revisions in both the format of the report and the methodology of the compilation of the figures. Initially, trade statistics were compiled using the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC), which classifies commodities by two criteria (1) the material of which the commodity has been made and (2) how the commodity will be used. This classification, subjected to periodic revisions, is still used today, though not predominantly.

The Harmonized System (HS) was adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council in June 1983 and enforced by the HS Convention in 1988. In 1993, the United Nations Statistical Commission, at its 27th session recommended that countries adopt the HS for the compilation and dissemination of their international trade statistics. In The Bahamas, however, the Customs Department did not implement the HS until July 1996 and the Department of Statistics followed suit in January, 1997. Since its implementation, the HS has been regularly revised, the latest occurred in 2012. However, the 2012 revision is not reflected in the 2012 figures/report as the changes will not take effect until July, 2013. As a result the figures in this 2012 report are reflective of the 2007 revision of the HS code.

The data in this report are collected from two data sources. The Bahamas Customs Department is the source for the trade statistics, while data for the **XMPI** are gathered through the conduct of a quarterly price survey of major importers and exporters. The **XMPI** data are presented in the HS format only, however both the SITC and the HS system of commodity classification are used in the presentation of the trade statistics.

Data Notes and Explanation

1. Data Source

The source documents of the statistics in this report are the Customs import entries, declarations and export documents submitted by importers and exporters, which are subject to verification and approval by The Bahamas Customs Department.

2. Coverage

As recommended by the United Nations International 'Merchandise Trade Statistics Manual', and to the extent possible, the General Trade System is used for the recording and compilation of external trade statistics for The Bahamas. This system covers all types of inward and outward movement of goods through a country or territory, including movements through warehouses and free zones. In essence, it includes all merchandise that either add to or reduce the stock of material resources of a country or territory by entering (imports) or leaving (exports) the country's economic territory.

3. Transaction Values

The value of imports are c.i.f., that is, the value at the port of importation including freight and insurance charges and other charges incidental to the delivery at the port of import.

The values of exports are f.o.b., that is, the value of goods including the cost of transportation and insurance to the border of the exporting country.

The values presented are Bahamian dollars and the exchange rates prevailing at the time of importation are used in converting foreign currencies.

4. Changes/Exclusion to Presentation of Trade Data

Excluded from the compilation of the foreign trade statistics are the goods traded that do not make any changes to the wealth and material resources of the country. Examples of such goods are crude oil, residual fuel oils and certain chemicals temporarily imported for storage purposes only.

5. Commodity Classification

The classifications of goods used in this report are the Harmonized Description and Coding System, better known as the Harmonized System (HS) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC). The HS arranges goods according to their degree of manufacture and classifies them into ninety-seven chapters which are grouped into twenty-one sections. Section twenty-two was added to accommodate local trade. The SITC on the other hand, arranges goods according to their stage of production. The SITC contains sixty-seven divisions which are condensed into ten sections.

Definitions and Abbreviations:

Imports – Goods imported from foreign countries for further processing or local consumption.

Domestic Exports – Goods produced or manufactured locally and exported to foreign countries.

Re-exports – goods exported in the same condition as when imported from a foreign country

Balance of Trade – is the total export minus the total import. It is usually calculated totally for a country or for each trading partner.

Port of Entry – a port that serves as a first port of entry from an international port.

2012 Annual Trade Data Highlights

Data on merchandise trade for the year 2012 show that the value of commodities imported into The Bahamas totaled some \$3.6 billion resulting in a moderate increase of nearly 7% above 2011's total of \$3.4 billion.

As it relates to major groups of merchandise the category of **'Mineral Fuels'** was the largest contributor to goods imported for 2012 totaling some \$875 million (or 23.9% of all imports). This category was followed by **'Machinery and Transport Equipment'** which totaled \$688 million (18.8% of all imports). **(Chart 1)**

Other major contributors to imports were the categories of **"Manufactured Goods"** which accounted for 14.3% of total imports with a total of \$524 million and the **'Food and Live Animals'** category (fresh meats, fruits & vegetables and processed foods) which totaled \$483.7 million (13.3% of total imports) **(Chart 1)**.

The commodities which contributed mainly to total imports were **'Diesel'** valued at \$375.8 million, **'Motor Gasoline (Unleaded)'** at \$226.3 million, **'Jet Fuel'** valued at \$88.7 million, and **'Other Fuel Oils'** at \$80.4 million. The combined value of these commodities represented 21.1% of total imports **(Table i)**.

Total exports (domestic and re-exports) totaled \$828.7 million in 2012 representing an increase of 14% over 2011. Domestic exports (\$337.5 million) accounted for 40.7% of total exports. The main contributors to domestic exports were the categories of **'Chemicals'** totaling \$230.6 million (68% of total domestic exports), **'Food and Live Animals'** totaling \$82.2 million (24% of total domestic exports), and **'Crude Minerals'** totaling \$23.9 million (7% of total domestic exports) **(Table 2.3)**. **'Chemicals'** showed an increase of 9.3% over 2011. Three commodities alone, 'expansible polystyrene' valued at \$146.4 million, 'other compounds containing a quinoline or isoquinoline ring' at \$75.6 million and 'spiny lobster tail frozen' at \$70.9 million accounted for some 86.8% of total domestic exports **(Table ii)**.

The balance of trade (total exports minus total imports) continued to result in a deficit with the trade balance increasing by \$144.9 million between 2011 and 2012. However, the percentage change in the trade balance between 2011 and 2012 was significantly lower (-5.4%) than it was (-18.5%) between 2010 and 2011.

Main Trading Partners

While there was a significant volume of trade as it relates to imports between The Bahamas and Puerto Rico (\$291.7 million) and Trinidad and Tobago (\$142.8 million), the United States (\$2.8 billion) maintained its position as The Bahamas' main trading partner representing 76.5% of total imports. In terms of exports the United States (\$675.6 million), France (\$25.0 million) and Canada (\$25.1 million) were among the top partner countries, representing 81.5%, 3.0% and 3.0% of total exports, respectively.

Trade between The Bahamas and CARICOM countries was minimal as the region represented less than 5% of total imports and less than one fifth of 1% of total exports. **Oil Products** imported from Trinidad and Tobago, valued at nearly \$141 million, accounted for 88.6% of total imports from the region. **Pharmaceutical Products** imported from Barbados and valued at \$1.7 million (1% of CARICOM imports) were again among the major imports from the region.

As in 2011, **Sea Salt** (valued at \$844 thousand) exported to Jamaica represented 57.6% of total exports to the region in 2012.

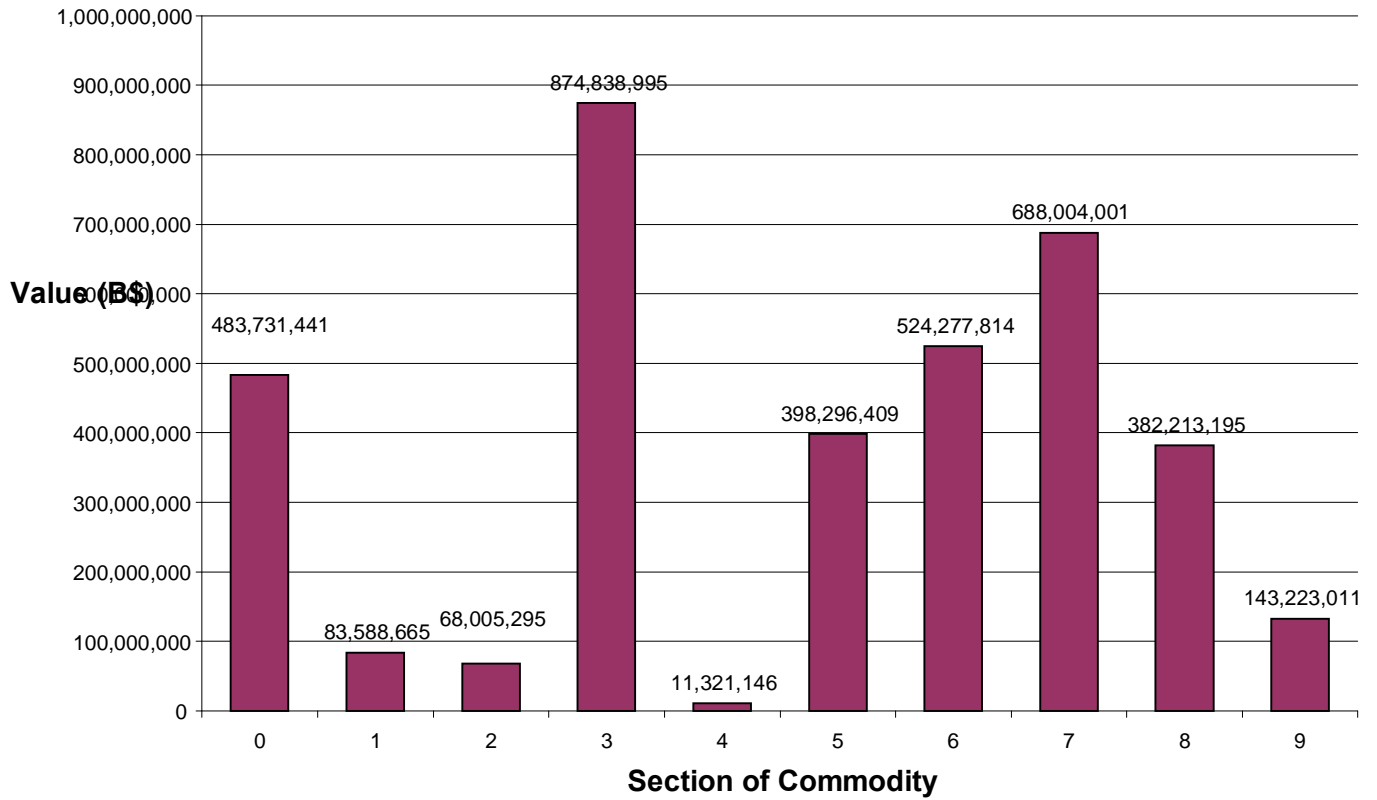

Value of Imports by Section of Commodity: 2012

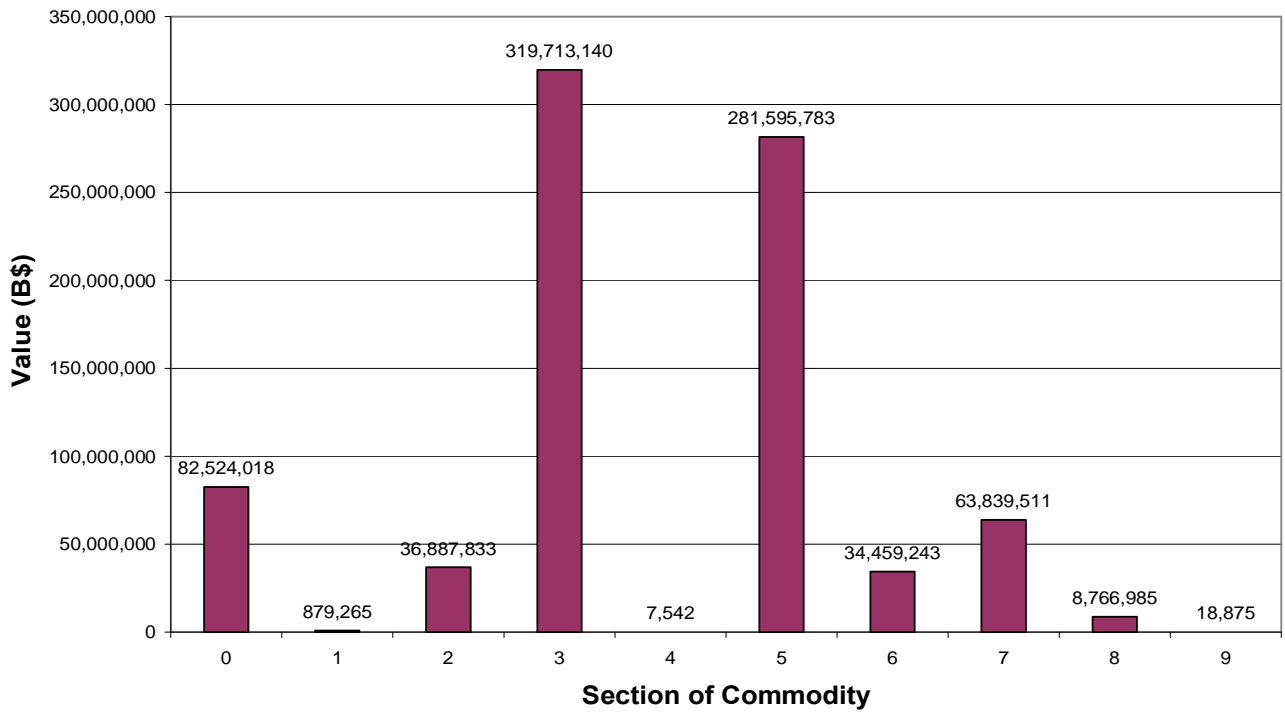

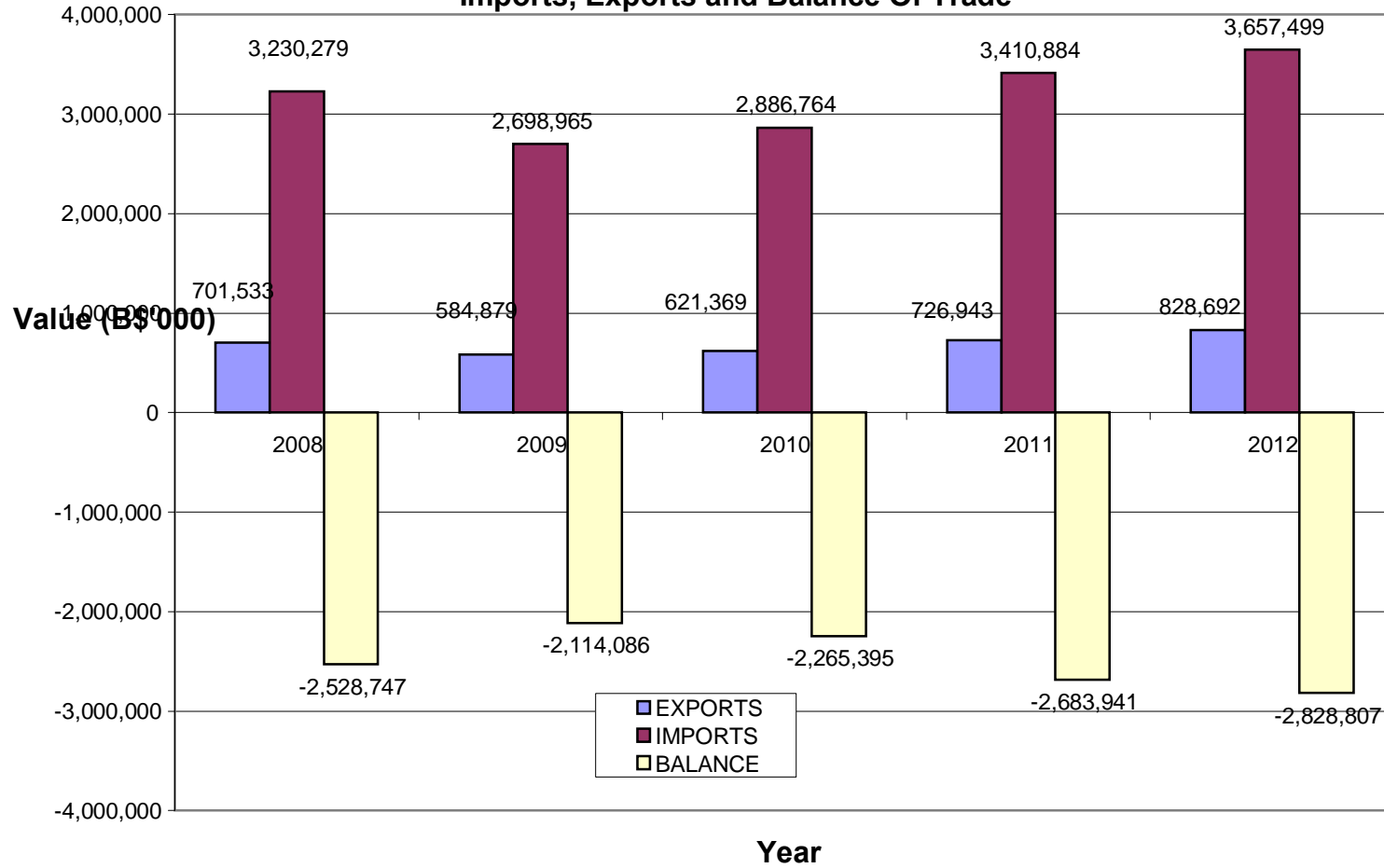
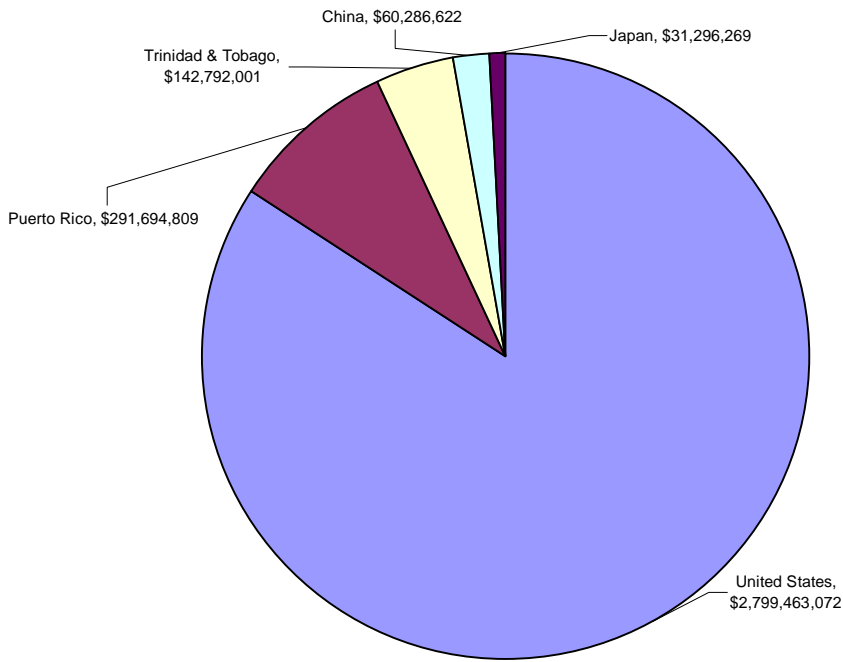
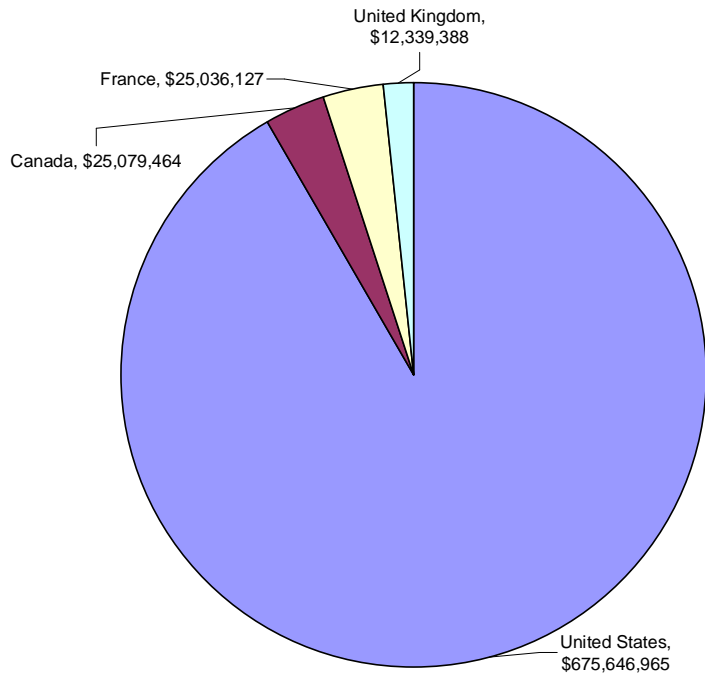

SECTION IV

2008 – 2011

METHODOLOGY FOR CONSTRUCTING AN EXPORT/IMPORT PRICE INDEX

An export import price index is defined as the average change in the cost of a selected basket of goods and services that is imported and exported. The items in the basket must be of same quantity and quality, in other words it must be homogeneous. The prices of a particular item will alter the overall cost of the basket. Thus the index measures this change over time. The basket includes those goods and services frequently purchased by importers and exporters. Therefore it is necessary to update the basket periodically to ensure that the index continues to be relevant.

Commodities Selection

Imports

For imports, which are large and diversified, all commodities and enterprises were listed in descending order according to their value of imports. First, the commodities were sorted by value of imports and a 70 percent cut-off on the cumulative value was applied at the eight digit HS level for both 2006 and 2007. These important commodities in each year were then compared to identify those that were important in both years and served as the basis for the commodity sample. The preliminary import sample included 264 commodities covering 66 percent of total 2007 imports. The next step was to perform a similar cut-off of 70 percent for the enterprises and to identify from the commodity list those enterprises trading in the selected commodities. Excluded from the sampling frame were HS codes beginning with 97 and above, including works of art and baggage entry items that were considered to be out of scope.

Exports

For exports, the sample selection was extracted for the calendar years 2006 and 2007. Exports are dominated by a few significant commodities. In order to have a sample that reflects other commodities that are important nationally, a cut-off level of BS\$1million was established; then those commodities that were exported in both years were identified and included in the sample. The preliminary export sample includes 10 commodities covering 97 percent of 2007 exports. The next step was to perform a similar cut off for the enterprises and to identify from the commodity list those enterprises trading in the selected commodities. Excluded from the sampling frame were HS codes beginning with 97 and above, including works of art and all re-exports items regardless of HS code. These items were considered to be out of scope.

Services

Tourism is reflected in the Balance of Payments as travel service which forms a major component for the BOP. The top ten major hotels were selected to represent accommodations based upon the number of rooms in the Hotel Directory published by the Ministry of Tourism for 2008. Restaurants in the non-inclusive hotels from this list were chosen to represent meals and drinks. Since initial price data for these establishments were not collected all the way back to the base year of 2007, base period prices were estimated by adjusting initiation prices back to 2007 using price trends for Average Room Rates published by the Ministry of Tourism.

Developing the Weights

Aggregate weights for commodities were derived from the 2006 Balance of Payments data. The weight is expressed as a percent of total exports and imports.

Once the enterprises and commodities were selected for export and import goods, the next step in deriving the weights was to allocate the weights for those enterprises and commodities not selected. When cutoff sampling is used the weight is the establishment's value of shipments plus a pro rata proportion of the value of shipments for the establishments not included in the sample. This allocation process involved extracting the commodity values in the sample, listing them, and then aggregating by commodity across enterprise.

The weights for hotels and restaurants were based on tourist expenditure data compiled by the Ministry of Tourism. The weights for the enterprises involved (hotels and restaurants) were derived as follows: The percentage share for each establishment is the number rooms in the hotel divided by the total number of rooms in the sample. All ten hotels were used for accommodations, but only the non-inclusive hotels were used for meals and drinks. This percentage share was then multiplied by the total expenditure on accommodations or meals and drinks reported by the Ministry of Tourism for 2007.

The initiation process

Before quarterly collection of prices began we had to do an initiation process which was conducted with each company. This process involved Trade Officers visiting sampled businesses to stress the importance of the index, establish cooperation, and receive basic information, such as the exact goods and services produced by the business. The main purposes of this visit are to:

- ❖ Find a suitable official to interview,
- ❖ Establish a good relationship with that person,
- ❖ Define the major import and export products or services to be priced for each HS-commodity or service area selected,
- ❖ Work with the respondent to find several representative transactions/varieties for continuous pricing,
- ❖ Determine the transaction weights (if more than one variety is selected) by asking the respondent to estimate the share of each representative transaction within the commodity group, and
- ❖ Specify the type and terms of transaction and record its detailed product characteristics.

Prices

An item can have between one to three price varieties. These prices are collected at the Cost Insurance and Freight (CIF) in the case of imports and Free On board (FOB) in the case of the exports. A special spreadsheet is developed in Microsoft Excel for the calculations.

Frequency of Collection

Prices for the imports are collected from the companies on a quarterly basis. For the exports however, prices are collected using the unit value which comes from Trade Data. Prices of services are collected directly from the hotels and via the internet.

Classification System

All items imported into the country are classified according to the United Nations Harmonized System (HS) classification which uses the following groupings.

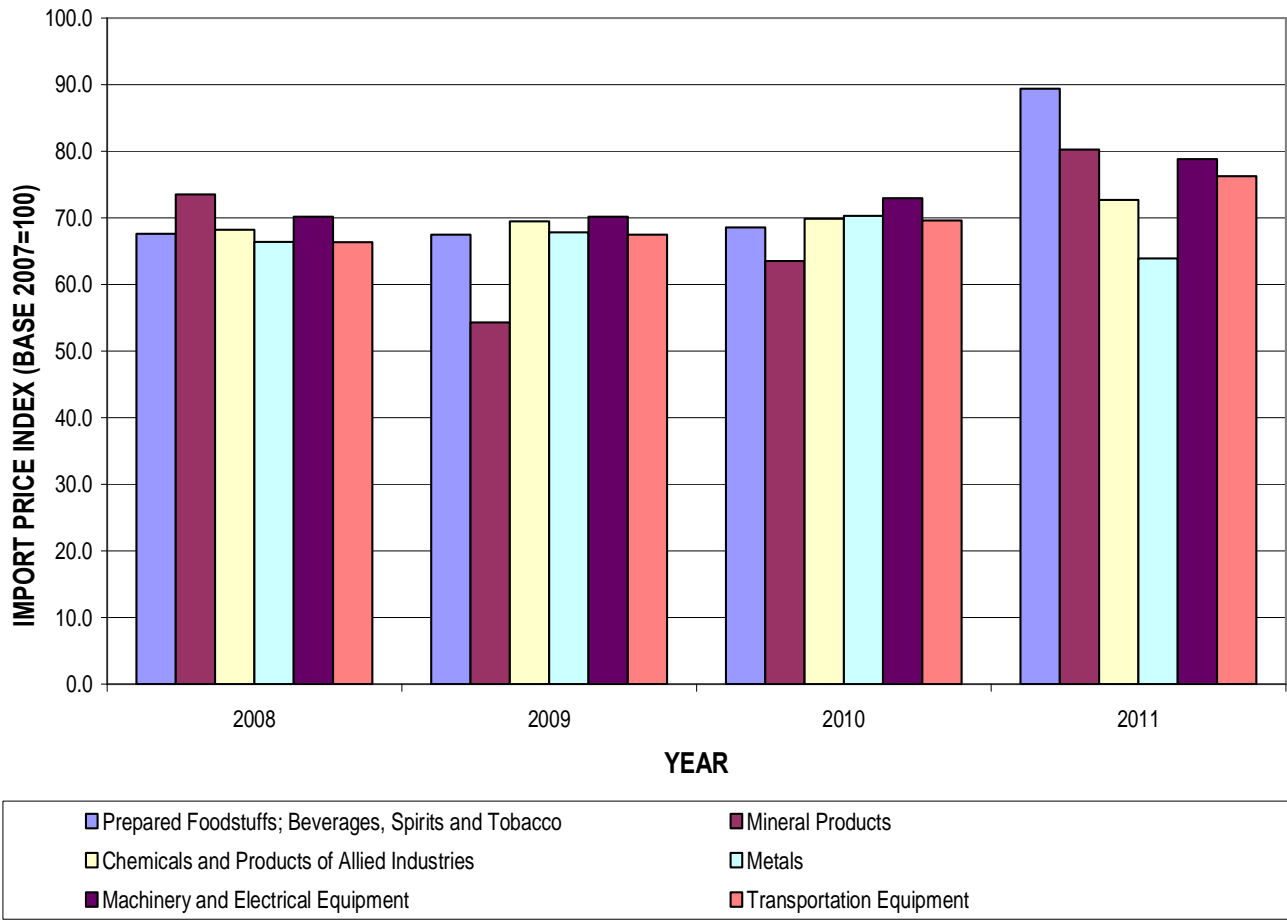
Conclusion

2008 - 2011 (BASE 2007=100)**

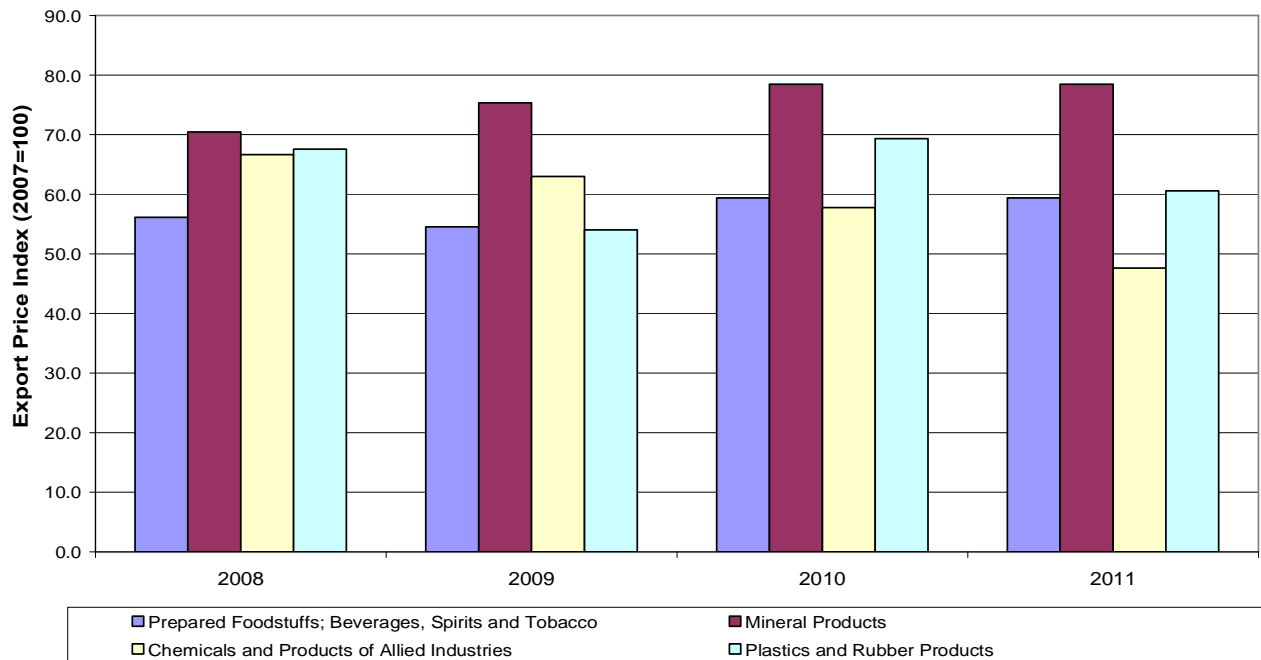

(2007=100)**

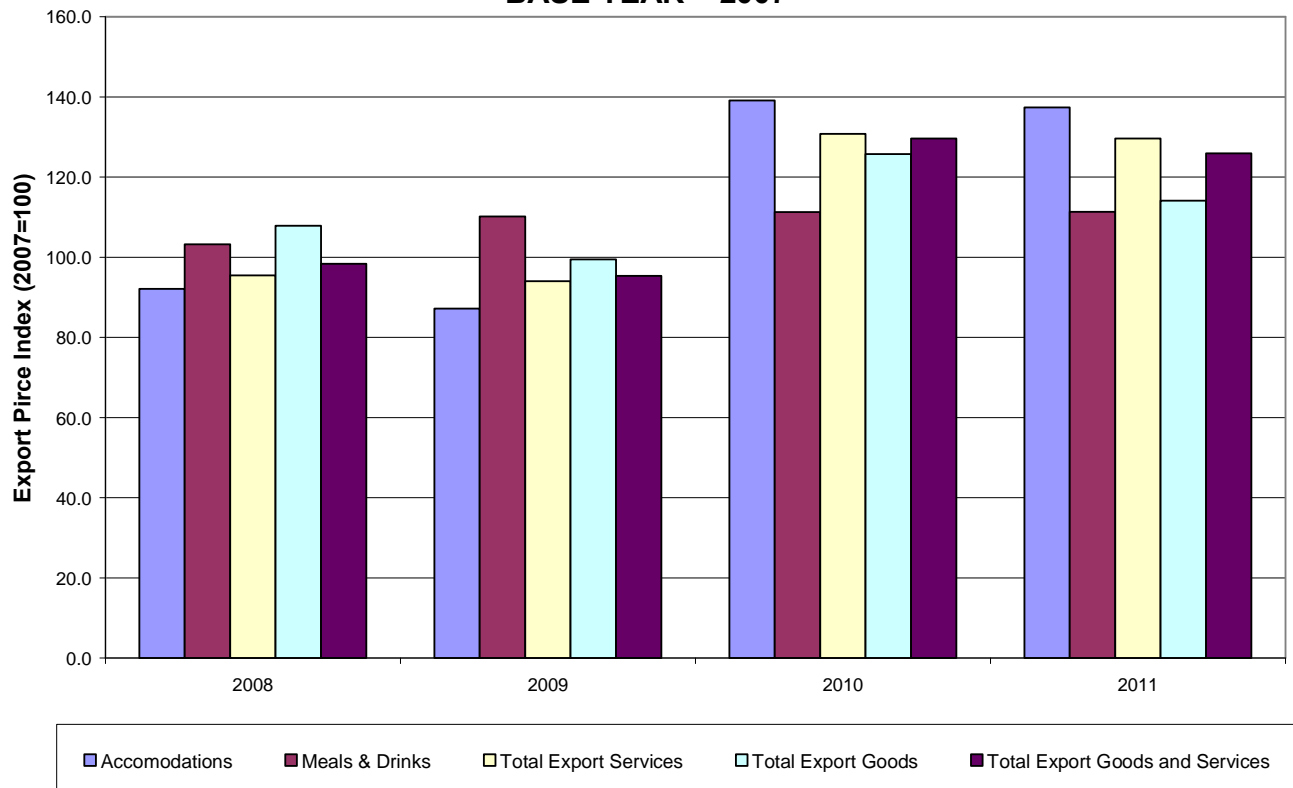



**ANNUAL SERVICE PRICE INDEX BY TYPE (BASE 2007=100)
