This report provides data on persons employed in the Accommodation and Food Service Activities

Industry in New Providence. The report contains information on occupation, sex, average hours worked

and average basic wages per week for the year 2022. The information provided in the document was

obtained from administrative data source of leading Accommodation and Food Service Activities

establishments which account for approximately fifty percent (50%) of total employment in these

establishments operating in New Providence in 2022. Though limited in this respect, the results do

provide valuable information on occupations, average basic wages (not including mandatory and other

gratuities for tip category workers) and average hours worked in the Accommodation and Food Service

Activities sector.

This report, previously named the 'Occupations & Wages Report in the Hotel Industry' was renamed

in 2011 to 'Occupations & Wages in the Accommodation and Food Service Activities Industry' to

comply with revised industrial classification outlined in the International Industrial Classification of All

Economic Activities (ISIC 2008). Up to 2012, this report provided data for All Bahamas, New

Providence and Grand Bahama and The Family Islands. However, all subsequent reports provide data

only for New Providence. The Bahamas National Statistical Institute wishes to acknowledge the valuable

cooperation and assistance of participating agencies such as the Department of Labour, The Bahamas

Hotel Employers' Association (BHEA) and the Bahamas Hotel Catering & Allied Workers Union (BHC

& AWU).

This report was prepared by Mrs. Cindy Stuart, Statistician II and Ms. Tricia Thurston, staff of the

Labour Market Information Unit. We gratefully acknowledge the assistance of the web administrator

DATA HIGHLIGHTS

According to the National Accounts Section of the Bahamas National Statistical Institute, economic activity in The Bahamas increased significantly by **11.9%** in nominal terms and by **14.4%** in real terms, as the business activity returned to pre—Covid 19 Pandemic levels. Most industries showed modest gains when compared to **2021**.

Accommodation and Food Services—increased significantly when compared to **2021** from \$550 million in 2021 to \$1.1 billion in 2022. This growth was largely due to increased tourism stopovers and a return of cruise visitors to the Bahamas, as Covid 19 travel restrictions and test requirements diminished globally.

In 2022, the number of workers in the Accommodation and Food Service Activities Industry in New Providence increased by 1,946 or 17.02%. The total number of male and female employees increased by 402 (6.7%) and 1,544 (29.4%) respectively. See Table 3

Service and Sales Workers was the largest occupational group in 2022, accounting for 39.3% of all workers in 2022 with 5,196 employees, an increase of 294 employees or 6.0% over 2021. This was followed by the **Elementary Occupations** group with 31.8% and 4,204 employees, a decrease of 769 employees or 15.5% compared to 2021. **See Table 3**

Average weekly wages of workers in the Hospitality Sector increased by 23.6% in 2022 when compared to 2021. The average weekly wage increased for males by 21.6% and for females by 26.1% respectively. **See Table 4**

In 2022, Managers earned the highest weekly wage of \$954. This was followed by **Professionals Science and Engineering Professional** who earned an average of \$896. However, the lowest average weekly wage of \$364 was earned in the **Service and Sales Workers. See Table 4**

In 2022, the total average hours worked was 38. Within the Industry, males worked an average of 40 hours per week and females worked an average of 36 hours per week. See Table 5

In 2022, the total average wage was \$463. Within the Industry, males earned an average wage of \$465 and females earned an average wage of \$462. See Table 5


