#### PRESS RELEASE

The Bahamas National Statistical Institute is pleased to announce the release of its 1<sup>ST</sup> Quarter 2024 Foreign Trade figures. This report presents data on merchandise trade that is imported and exported into and from The Bahamas.

#### 1st QUARTER 2024 TRADE DATA HIGHLIGHTS

## **Imports**

Estimates on commodities imported into The Bahamas totaled some \$1,027 billion dollars resulting in an increase of less than 1% when compared with the same period last year.


'Machinery & Transport Equipment' the largest contributor to imports, totaled some \$240 million (or 17% of all imports). This was followed by the category of 'Food & Live Animals' which accounted for less than 1% or \$199 million.

Other categories that contributed significantly to total imports were 'Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles', 'Mineral Fuels, Lubricants & Related Materials', and 'Chemicals' with a combined total of \$329 million (32% of total imports).

# **Exports**

Total exports (domestic and re-exports) for 1st quarter 2024 totaled \$95 million resulting in a significant decrease of 44% when compared to the same period last year. The major categories of exports consisted mainly of 'Food and Live Animals' totaling \$24 million (25% of total exports), 'Mineral Fuels, Lubricants And Related Articles' totaling 23 million (24% of total exports) and 'Crude Minerals' totaling \$14 million (15% of total export).

'Manufactured Goods Classified Chiefly by Materials', 'Machinery & Transport Equipment' and 'Mineral Fuels, Lubricants and Related Materials' showed decreases of 82%, 65%, 54% respectively.
