

## VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS ENTERING THE BAHAMAS

### **Yellow Fever**

Country requirement: a yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers over 1 year of age arriving from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission and for travelers having transited more than 12 hours through the airport of a country with risk of yellow fever transmission. The following countries are listed below.

**Africa:** Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Sao Tome and Principe, South Sudan, Somalia, Sudan, Togo, Uganda and United Republic of Tanzania.

**South America:** Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, French Guiana, Panama, Paraguay, Peru and Venezuela.

### **Malaria**

Malaria: Sporadic local transmission of *P. falciparum* has been reported in recent years on Great Exuma island only, subsequent to international importation of parasites. No risk on other islands. Recommended prevention on Great Exuma island: Mosquito bite prevention only Rabies Low risk Pre-exposure immunization recommended for people likely to have contact with bats.
