**THE BAHAMAS NATIONALITY (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2018**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of The Bahamas Nationality Act (*Ch. 190*), makes the following Regulations —

1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as The Bahamas Nationality (Amendment) Regulations, 2018.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 2018.

2. Amendment to Second Schedule to Sub. Leg. Vol. II, Ch. 190 - 3.

The second column to the Second Schedule to The Bahamas Nationality Regulations is amended —

- (a) in Item 1, by the deletion of the word “20.00” and the substitution of the word “500.00”;
 - (b) in Item 2, by the deletion of the word “50.00” and the substitution of the word “200.00”;
 - (c) in Item 3 —
 - (i) by the deletion of the words “\$20.00”, “50.00” and “100.00” in paragraphs (a) and (b), and the substitution of the words “100.00”, “200.00” and “400.00” respectively;
 - (ii) by the deletion of the word “20.00” in paragraph (c) and the substitution of the word “NIL”; and
 - (iii) by the deletion of the word “20.00” in paragraph (d) and the substitution of the word “100.00”;
 - (d) in Item 4, by the deletion of the words “500.00” and “50.00” and the substitution of the words “1000.00” and “200.00” respectively;
 - (e) in Item 5, by the deletion of the word “20.00” and the substitution of the word “200.00”;
 - (f) in Item 6, by the deletion of the word “20.00” and the substitution of the word “200.00”;

- (g) by the deletion of Item 7; and
- (h) in Item 8, by the deletion of the word "5.00" and the substitution of the word "25.00".
